Badge Pick up:

Proceed to Registration located in Hall 6 and pick up badges at the **Sponsor/Exhibitor Registration** line.

The ISEF College & Career Fair exhibitor hours will take place during the first two days of ISEF (Sunday, May 10- Monday, May 11). We've extended the College & Career Fair hours over two days to provide finalists with as much time as possible during the full ISEF schedule to interact with exhibitors.

Most finalists arrive at ISEF on Saturday and Sunday and will be setting up their projects on Sunday and Monday in preparation for the competition, so you should expect the traffic to the College & Career Fair to ebb and flow on both days of the fair.

On Sunday, the fair is also open to Phoenix area students and parents. Local students will not be wearing badges.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

The Registration area, College & Career Fair and the ISEF Store share open space in Exhibit Hall 6, so the exhibit hall will be open to attendees from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Sunday and Monday.

The College & Career Fair exhibit booths will be accessible to attendees when the fair is not in session. Please take this into consideration when leaving items unattended at your booth, as anyone in the hall will be able to peruse the College & Career Fair booths during these times.

- EXHIBITOR SET-UP HOURS 3:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

If you plan to arrive early and would like to set up your booth on Saturday, you may do so during the above hours. Since the College & Career Fair does not open officially until Sunday afternoon, any items/giveaways you don't want taken should not be left on your tabletop.

Sunday, May 10

- EXHIBITOR SET-UP HOURS 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

- COLLEGE & CAREER FAIR OPEN 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

You may set up your booth during set-up hours. The College & Career Fair does not officially open until 1:00 p.m. but since the hall will be open to ISEF attendees at 8:00 a.m., you're welcome to occupy your booth sooner if you like.

Exhibitors are welcome to leave their booth unoccupied and take breaks at their discretion.

The exhibit hall will not be closed for lunch. Exhibitors are free to leave their booths unoccupied and take lunch and other breaks at their discretion. Food concessions will be available onsite and other options are available offsite nearby.

If you'd like to view finalists projects, exhibitors will have access to the finalist exhibit hall on Monday afternoon (finalists will not be at their booths).

- ISEF LEADERS RECEPTION 5:30 p.m. – 6:45 p.m.

ISEF College & Career Fair Lead Retrieval via StriveScan

The **College & Career Fair at Regeneron ISEF** is partnering with **StriveScan** to bring electronic student scanning to our event.

Using the StriveScan mobile app, you will be able to easily scan students' barcodes to collect their information when they visit your booth. This will save you time and provide students with more time to have valuable conversations with you.

To create your StriveScan account go to <https://app.strivescan.com/> and complete the **“College Representative Registration”** form.

Download the **Strivescan** app to be able scan student barcodes.

A few reminders:

- If other colleagues will be joining you, encourage them to [create an account](#).

Regeneron ISEF App

College & Career Fair Passport

All ISEF finalists will receive a Passport encouraging them to visit with a variety of exhibitors. College & Career Fair exhibitors are listed inside the passport and divided into Groups. When finalists visit your booth, you can stamp their passport in the Group where your institution is listed. Finalists who collect stamps from all ten exhibitor Groups will be entered into an ISEF Store gift certificate prize drawing. Stamps will be provided for exhibitors.

Booth Traffic

Prior to and during the event, we've promoted the College & Career Fair to attendees, via messaging through e-mail and digital channels. Finalists will also be provided with an ISEF Passport that they can get stamped when visiting with exhibitors to be eligible to win ISEF Store gift certificates. In addition, The ISEF Store will be centrally located among the College & Career Fair booths, further encouraging traffic flow into the exhibit hall.

Because finalists/students will have multiple things competing for their time, we've spread the College & Career Fair hours over two days to provide them with as much time as possible during the full ISEF schedule to interact with exhibitors. You should expect traffic to ebb and flow.

The exhibit hall will not be closed to break for lunch. Exhibitors are free to leave their booths unoccupied and take lunch and other breaks at their discretion. If You Are Carrying Materials to your booth

Exhibitors are permitted to carry their materials from the entrance to the convention center to their booths. PLEASE NOTE: If you have oversized or heavy items, you may use your own hand cart but if you require assistance from GES to help transport your items on site, additional charges will be incurred.
